For Greg Epstein, and his Teton Gravity Research team, Revelstoke had it all when they were scouting for their latest film, *Almost Ablaze*, “We chose Revelstoke because of the snow quality, extensive, playful terrain, and the ability to get out every day whether by foot, lift, heli or snowcat,” he said. “Based on our athletes' experience TGR will be back in the Revelstoke area for years to come.”

High budget films hitting the big screen this fall with Revelstoke in a leading role include: Unicorn Picnic (*Pretty Faces*), Teton Gravity Research (*Almost Ablaze*), Matchstick Productions (*Days of my Youth*), Poorboyz (*Twenty*) and Absinthe (*Heavy Mental*).
