



Direct Flights to Service Revelstoke Mountain Resort for 2016-17 Winter Season

Revelstoke, BC – Revelstoke Mountain Resort, in partnership with the City of Revelstoke and Revelstoke Accommodation Association, is excited to announce new air service from Vancouver to Revelstoke for the 2016-17 winter season.

From January 26 to March 19, 2017, direct flights will be offered on Thursdays and Sundays. The service will be operated by Pacific Coastal Airlines with flights leaving from Vancouver's South Terminal and landing at the Revelstoke Airport, just one kilometre from the resort. Local operator, Everything Revelstoke, will be managing the bookings and will also provide ground transport.

"This new service offers a great option for winter visitors to quickly and easily get to Revelstoke at a reasonable price point," explained Peter Nielsen, VP Operations at Revelstoke Mountain Resort. "I think guests are going to be really excited about the short one-hour trip that helps maximize their time on the mountain. They can ski a full day, and then hop on their flight."

The Vancouver-Revelstoke flights will be operated on a Beechcraft 1900 series with 15 seats available for sale. Prices for a one-way ticket will range from \$249 to \$299, including taxes, fees, 50 lbs of luggage, and ground transport. Private charters are also available.
