Revelstoke Mountain Resort (RMR) is a four season destination resort located in the Columbia Mountains of British Columbia and just minutes from the established town of Revelstoke. Revelstoke is located 200 kilometers (124 miles) north east of Kelowna and 413 kilometers (257 miles) west of Calgary. RMR is North Americas most significant resort development in over a quarter century. In winter, the resort boasts the highest lift-serviced vertical descent in North America and is the only resort in the world which offers lift-skiing, cat-skiing, helicopter-skiing and back-country skiing right from the village base.
