The village also keeps everything close at hand, with ski and snowboard rentals, on-mountain repairs, and retail shopping for gear and essentials, making it easy to get from first chair to après.

Lessons That Build Confidence: Revelstoke's [Mountain Sports School](#) offers expert instruction for kids and adults, helping everyone feel comfortable and confident on the mountain. RMR offers a range of instruction from one-on-one lessons to 10-week group courses and holiday break programs.

More Than Just Skiing: Beyond the slopes, families can enjoy scenic gondola rides, on-mountain dining, and relaxing après-ski moments in a charming alpine setting.

Small-Town Charm, World-Class Setting: Revelstoke combines the friendliness of a mountain town just 6 KM away with the amenities of a premier resort, making visitors feel right at home.

A Destination for All Seasons: Revelstoke is a year-round getaway, offering summer adventures including hiking, mountain biking, gondola sightseeing, and signature experiences like the [Pipe Mountain Coaster](#) and [Revelstoke Skywalk](#) featuring a high-alpine suspension bridge and cantilevered viewing platform with sweeping mountain views. In 2027, the Cabot Revelstoke golf course will open, offering a world-class mountain golf experience.

RESORT BACKGROUND & EVOLUTION

MOUNT MACKENZIE BEFORE 2007

Long before Revelstoke Mountain Resort opened, Mount Mackenzie was already known within the ski community for its deep snowfall and challenging terrain. Skiing in Revelstoke dates back more than a century, with early ski clubs, ski jumping and routes established in the early 1900s as the community developed a strong mountain culture rooted in skiing. Lift-served skiing on Mount Mackenzie began in the 1960s, and through the following decades heli-skiing and cat-skiing operations helped establish Revelstoke's international reputation for deep snowfall, steep terrain, and backcountry adventure. While infrastructure remained modest, these early operations shaped the identity of the mountain and laid the foundation for the development of a modern destination resort.

RESORT DEVELOPMENT & OPENING - 2007

Revelstoke Mountain Resort officially opened on December 21, 2007, marking the transition from primarily backcountry access to modern lift-served skiing on Mount Mackenzie. The installation of the Revelation Gondola and Stoke Chair opened expansive alpine terrain to the public for the first time, creating one of North America's newest destination ski resorts. Subsequent expansion of lift infrastructure and terrain access established Revelstoke's defining feature: the longest lift-served vertical descent in North America. This positioned the resort among the continent's premier big-mountain ski destinations.

EXPANSION & FOUR-SEASON EVOLUTION - 2008 TO TODAY

Since opening, Revelstoke Mountain Resort has continued to evolve through terrain development, lift additions, and growth within the resort village. Enhancements to mountain access and guest experience have supported steady growth while maintaining the steep, fall-line skiing and authentic mountain character that define Revelstoke. In recent years, the resort has expanded its focus beyond winter, developing summer sightseeing, mountain biking, and adventure experiences as part of its evolution into a four-season mountain destination, alongside continued real estate and village development at the base of Mount Mackenzie.



NORTHLAND & RMR RELATIONSHIP

Northland Properties Corporation (Northland), a 100 per cent Canadian-owned hospitality and real estate company founded in 1963, is the parent company and long-term steward of Revelstoke Mountain Resort. Northland acquired the resort in 2008 as part of its strategic expansion into world-class mountain destinations, and has since integrated Revelstoke into its diverse portfolio of brands alongside hotels, restaurants, and other leisure properties.

Under Northland's ownership, Revelstoke Mountain Resort has benefited from long-term investment, thoughtful development planning, and alignment with Northland's broader vision of creating memorable experiences and vibrant communities across its properties. Today, Revelstoke is positioned as a premier four-season destination contributing to the company's commitment to quality hospitality and unique guest experiences across Canada and beyond.

WINTER FACT SHEET

The following highlights provide a seasonal overview of winter operations and experiences at Revelstoke Mountain Resort.

1,713 M VERTICAL DROP (5,620 FT)

Longest Vertical in North America: Revelstoke Mountain Resort boasts a lift-accessed vertical drop of the longest in all of North America.

3,121 ACRES OF SKIABLE TERRAIN

Huge Skiable Terrain: The resort offers skiable terrain spread across Mount Mackenzie.

10.5 M OF SNOW ANNUALLY

Record Snowfall: Revelstoke averages approximately 10.5 m of snowfall each winter. That's about 34 feet of snow annually.

512 M ELEVATION AT BASE

Mountain Elevation: The base of the resort sits at 512 m elevation, while the Stoke Chair tops out around 2,225 m above sea level.

4 MAJOR BOWLS

Four High-Alpine Bowls: Revelstoke's terrain includes four major bowls, South Bowl, North Bowl, Separate Reality, and Greely Bowl, ideal for deep snow and wide-open skiing.

BROAD ACCESS

Winter Lifts and Access: The resort's lift network includes the Revelstoke Gondola plus high-speed chairs (Stoke, Ripper, Stellar) and magic carpets on beginner slopes, providing broad access up the mountain.

2 TERRAIN PARKS

Terrain Parks: RMR is home to two terrain parks, the Main Terrain Park and the Gnome Zone, with jumps, rails, boxes, and progression features for freestyle riders.

INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION

Award-Winning Destination: Revelstoke Mountain Resort has been recognized by the World Ski Awards, including being named Canada's Best Ski Resort, and continues to be nominated among the country's top ski destinations.

SUMMER FACT SHEET

The following highlights provide a seasonal overview of summer operation and mountain experiences at Revelstoke Mountain Resort.

OPERATES JUN-SEPT

Extended Summer Season: Summer operations at Revelstoke Mountain Resort typically run from early June through late September each year.

MOUNTAIN COASTER REACHES SPEEDS OF 42 KM/H

Mountain Coaster Thrills: The Pipe Mountain Coaster, the resort's flagship summer attraction, including two tracks, can reach speeds of up to 42 km/h as riders descend through twists, turns, and tunnels.

1.4 KM OF RAIL-GUIDED TRACK

Coaster Track Length: The Pipe Mountain Coaster spans down the mountain.

1,676 M GONDOLA ELEVATION (5,500 FT)

Gondola Elevation Access: The Revelation Gondola carries guests to elevations of roughly 5,500 ft (about 1,676 m) for summer sightseeing and trail access.

50+. KM OF MOUNTAIN BIKING TRAILS

Lift-Accessed Mountain Biking: Revelstoke Mountain Resort's bike park offers over 50 km of lift-accessed trails, featuring a progressive mix of downhill descents, technical terrain, and flow trails. Highlights include the iconic Fifty-Six Twenty trail, which descends the resort's full 1,713 m (5,620 ft) vertical, delivering one of the longest continuous flow descents in North America.

ALPINE HIKING ROUTES

Nature Play: Hiking options from the top of the Revelation Gondola include numerous alpine routes, including the Stoke Climb (7 km one way), guiding visitors through meadows, forest, and expansive mountain viewpoints.

ROPE COURSE WITH 50 OBSTACLES

Adventure Course Scale: The Aerial Adventure Park spans a four-story ropes course for participants of varying skill levels.

SCENIC EXPERIENCES

Scenic Experiences: The resort's signature attraction is the Revelstoke Skywalk, featuring a high-alpine suspension bridge and cantilevered viewing platform that offers sweeping mountain views. The entire Stellar Chair area has been designed to deliver an accessible alpine experience for beginners, making it an ideal starting point to build skills and progress from.

PASSES

ADVENTURE PASS

An all-access pass providing entry to the resort's core summer attractions, including the Pipe Mountain Coaster, Revelstoke Skywalk, Aerial Adventure Park, sightseeing via the Revelation Gondola, and disc golf, offering a full day of on-mountain experiences.

EXPLORE PASS

A summer pass that includes Revelation Gondola access, the Revelstoke Skywalk, and endless opportunities for hiking and sightseeing.

FAMILY-FRIENDLY SUMMER PROGRAMS

Weekly Summer Adventure Camps run for 5 days from ~8:45 AM to 4:15 PM for children ages 5–13, blending guided hikes, games, and outdoor skills.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS REVELSTOKE MOUNTAIN RESORT?

Revelstoke Mountain Resort (RMR) is a four-season mountain destination located in Revelstoke, British Columbia. Opened in 2007 on Mount Mackenzie, the resort is known for its big-mountain terrain, high annual snowfall, and the longest lift-served vertical descent in North America at 1,713 metres (5,620 feet). RMR combines lift-served skiing and snowboarding with summer mountain experiences, slope-side accommodation, dining, and ongoing resort village and real estate development.

WHAT IS REVELSTOKE MOUNTAIN RESORT BEST KNOWN FOR?

Revelstoke is widely recognized for its fall-line skiing, extensive vertical, and consistent snowfall, averaging approximately 10.5 metres (34 feet) annually. The resort is known for alpine bowls, gladed terrain, and long descents that appeal to intermediate and advanced skiers, while also offering beginner terrain and learning areas at lower elevations.

IS REVELSTOKE SUITABLE FOR BEGINNER AND INTERMEDIATE SKIERS OR FAMILIES?

While Revelstoke Mountain Resort is widely known for its advanced and big-mountain terrain, the resort also offers beginner and intermediate runs accessible from the Revelation Gondola and lower mountain areas. Dedicated learning terrain, ski and snowboard school programs, and progression-focused zones support newer skiers and riders, including families visiting together with mixed ability levels. Families can also access non-ski activities and summer experiences that make the resort suitable for year-round visits.

HOW DOES HELI-SKIING FIT INTO THE REVELSTOKE EXPERIENCE?

Revelstoke has long been considered one of the world's premier heli-skiing destinations, with operations in the surrounding Selkirk and Monashee Mountains predating the resort itself. Guests visiting Revelstoke Mountain Resort often combine lift-served skiing with guided heli-skiing experiences through local operators. This connection reflects the region's longstanding backcountry skiing culture and contributes to Revelstoke's global reputation as a powder destination.

WHAT LIFT PASSES AND ACCESS PROGRAMS ARE AVAILABLE?

Revelstoke Mountain Resort offers [day tickets](#), multi-day lift products, and [season passes](#). The resort also participates in major multi-resort pass programs, including [Ikon Pass](#) and [Mountain Collective](#), allowing passholders to include Revelstoke as part of broader destination travel itineraries.

WHAT ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE?

The resort village includes slope-side accommodation at [The Sutton Place Hotel](#), offering ski-in, ski-out access and proximity to lifts, dining, rentals, and guest services. The resort village will also welcome The Cabot Revelstoke Mountain Lodge Hotel, an upcoming slopeside accommodation addition expanding on-mountain lodging options. Additional accommodation options are available in the City of Revelstoke, located approximately 10 minutes from the resort base, including full-service hotels such as the [Sandman Hotel Revelstoke](#), independent lodges, and vacation rentals. Staying in town provides access to Revelstoke's restaurants, shops, and local amenities while remaining a short drive from the resort.

DOES REVELSTOKE MOUNTAIN RESORT OFFER REAL ESTATE OPPORTUNITIES?

[Real estate development](#) is an ongoing component of the resort's long-term vision and includes a range of residential opportunities within and adjacent to the resort. Current offerings include neighbourhoods such as Mountain Road Estates, featuring estate homes and duplex-style residences located on resort lands, and Benchlands Residences, a master-planned community offering condominiums, townhomes, and estate lots designed for four-season mountain living. Additional residential neighbourhoods and future phases are planned as part of the resort's ongoing village expansion, supporting the evolution of Revelstoke Mountain Resort as an integrated, year-round mountain community.

WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO VISIT?

The winter skiing and riding season typically runs from early December through April. January through March are known for consistent snowfall and powder conditions, while late winter and spring offer longer days and variable snow conditions. Summer operations typically run from late spring through early fall, featuring sightseeing, mountain biking, hiking, and family-oriented mountain activities.

WHAT ACTIVITIES ARE AVAILABLE OUTSIDE OF WINTER?

During summer, Revelstoke Mountain Resort operates sightseeing via the Revelation Gondola, access to hiking and mountain biking trails, the [Pipe Mountain Coaster](#), aerial adventure experiences, and the [Revelstoke Skywalk](#), featuring a high-alpine suspension bridge and cantilevered viewing platform. These offerings support the resort's evolution as a four-season destination.
